


Discovered:

- God told Moses to take a census of all men 20 years & older: 603,550
- Reuben 46,500 Judah 74,600 Ephraim 40,500 Dan 62,700
- Simeon 59,300 Issachar 54,400 Manasseh 32,200 Asher 41,500
- Gad 45,650 Zebulon 57,400 Benjamin 35,400 Naphtali 53,400
- Levites were not counted as they were responsible for the tabernacle.



- When Israelites traveled with the ark, they went: Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, Reuben, Simeon, Gad, Levites & tabernacle, Ephraim, Manasseh, Benjamin, Dan, Asher, Naphtali
- The Levites were taken instead of firstborn to guard/serve the tabernacle.
- There was a tax for every 1st born not equal to Levites over age of 30 (age to serve) of 5 shekels
- When Israelites moved Aaron & sons were only ones allowed to pack up the tabernacle, ark
- Unclean persons, male & female were to live outside the camp
- Those who commit sins need to confess their sins & make restitution in full + 1/5
- For women accused of adultery, there was a test to detect faithfulness.
- Nazirite: a vow of service to God made by a person, during the vow they could not drink/consume fruit of the vine, cut their hair or go near a dead person during service.
- On the day the tabernacle was set up, each of the tribes gave: silver plate & basin filled with flour & oil, gold dish with incense, one bull, one ram, male lamb (1 year), male goat, 2 oxen, 5 rams, 5 male goats & 5 male lambs.
- Levites were cleansed for service: sprinkled with water, shaved & brought burnt, grain & sin offerings. They served from 25 years old to 50 years old.
