

Passage: Exodus 1-15:21

Date: 1.17.2020

Discovered:

- Jacob's descendants continued to multiply in Egypt.  
↳ Egypt & Pharaoh grew afraid of their numbers, afraid they would join their enemies & revolt against them so they enslaved them, put them to work building storehouses & in fields.
- Pharaoh told the Hebrew midwives to kill all baby boys born but they refused telling Pharaoh the Hebrew women would give birth without them → they were blessed with families as a result of their fear of God.
- Pharaoh then commanded that all the Hebrew baby boys be thrown into the Nile.
- A woman put her baby boy in a basket and put it in the Nile. Pharaoh's daughter saw it & rescued him, claiming him as her own, named him Moses. Miriam, his sister, fetched her mother for Pharaoh's daughter to nurse the baby, since she was watching over the baby.
- As an adult, Moses saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew and killed him, hiding it. When discovered, Pharaoh wanted to kill Moses, so he fled to Midian.
- Moses settled with Jethro & married his daughter, Zipporah.
- God heard the Israelites groaning & approached Moses in the form of a burning bush, saying Moses would deliver them out of Egypt & to the promised land.  
→ Moses fears that he will not be believed & is given signs: Staff into serpent, leperous hand & water into blood. God also sent Aaron to speak for Moses. No excuses.
- Moses takes his family to Egypt & appears with Aaron before Pharaoh to let the people go worship in the desert. Pharaoh says no & punishes them by making the work harder. Israelites become angry @ Moses - doubt his promise of deliverance.
- Moses and Aaron perform the sign of the staff but it is replicated & Pharaoh heart hardened.
- 1<sup>st</sup> plague: All water turned into blood, magicians matched, so Pharaoh's heart hardened.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> plague: frogs everywhere, magicians matched, so Moses removed then Pharaoh lied.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> plague: dust into gnats, magicians couldn't repeat, Pharaoh's heart hardened.
- 4<sup>th</sup> plague: flies, Pharaoh promised but his heart hardened - did not let go.
- 5<sup>th</sup>: Egyptian livestock die. Pharaoh's heart hardened - did not let people go.
- 6<sup>th</sup>: Boils on everyone - Pharaoh's heart hardened - did not let people go.
- 7<sup>th</sup>: Hail & fire - destroyed everything left outside - Pharaoh deceived them to stop it.
- 8<sup>th</sup>: Locusts, Pharaoh deceived again.
- 9<sup>th</sup>: Darkness for three days - light for Israelites in Goshen.

Passover = kill a lamb, brush its blood on doorpost, eat it roasted w/ bitter herbs & unleavened bread to prevent loss of firstborn.

• 10<sup>th</sup>: firstborn died - Pharaoh let them go & they took everything including riches from Egyptians

Pharaoh changed his mind & went after them. Moses parted the Red Sea so they could escape. Egyptian Army drowned.
