

Passage: 1 Chronicles 1-14

Discovered:

- Ch 1: Reviews genealogy from Adam to Abraham then Abraham to Jacob/Israel
Abraham → Isaac → Israel
- Ch 2: Genealogy of David from Israel on.
Israel → Judah → Perez → Hezron → Ram → Amminadab → Nashon → Salmon → Boaz → Obed → Jesse → David (7th son)
- Ch 3: Descendants of David
- Ch 4: Descendants of Judah - one of the descendants was Jabez - more honorable than his brothers
- were linen workers & potters
- Ch 4: Descendants of Simeon - defeated the Meunites & Amalekites
- Ch 5: Descendants of Reuben - lived in the east, defeated Hagrites in days of Saul, lived in tents, tended livestock
- Descendants of Gad - lived near Reuben - prevailed over their enemies, skilled warriors
- Half-tribe of Manasseh - numerous but worshipped gods of the people of the land - taken into exile by Pul of Assyria w/ Reubenites & Gad.
- Ch 6: Levites - ministered to the people through songs, service to the tabernacle, along with the sons of Aaron who were in charge of offerings
- Ch 7: Descendants of Issachar, Benjamin, Naphtali, Manasseh, Ephraim, & Asher
- Ch 8: Genealogy of Israel's first king, Saul, a Benjaminite
- Ch 9: Genealogy of returned exiles - first to return after exile to Babylon were priests, Levites & some from Judah, Benjamin, Ephraim & Manasseh
- Ch 10: Recounts Saul's death, Saul fell on his sword to prevent death by Philistines. Saul died as a result of a breach of faith: sought guidance from a medium.
- Ch 11: David was anointed king by Samuel and captured Jerusalem from Jebusites, making it the capital (Israel)
- Descriptions of David's mighty men, 33 in all. These were the men who joined David while hiding from Saul.
- There were near 350,000 men who showed their support to make David, King of Israel.
- David wanted to bring the ark from Kirath-jearim to Jerusalem
↳ While they were moving the ark, Uzzah reached out his hand to steady the ark & was killed by God. So they left it with Obed-edom out of fear.
- David built a house for himself. He took more wives & had more children.
- David defeated Philistines
