

Passage: Psalm 61-90

Date: 2.23.2020

Discovered:

- 61: David is praying for the strength & security that comes from God & His faithful watch over him.
- 62: David is relying on the hope that comes from God & tells others to put their trust in Him.
- 63: David seeks the Lord; you satisfy my soul & are my defense.
- 64: David: When I take refuge in You, hidden from my enemies, you're my defender.
- 65: Praises to the Lord, you are my savior, creator & protector.
- 66: Praise & give thanks to the Lord for He loves me & for the awesome work of His hands.
- 67: Praise the Lord for He saves us, is a fair judge & increases our harvest.
- 68: Tells of the Exodus of Egypt to settlement of their inheritance: Israel. Praise Him.
- 69: Lord, rescue me from my many enemies in your time for heaven & earth praise You!
- 70: Deliver me quickly - a prayer for urgent help.
- 71: With confidence & hope in You. I ask for deliverance, I will praise You.
- 72: Solomon asks for blessings for king of Israel: judge with righteousness, peace, compassion for those in need & prosperity.
- 73: Asaph: Even though the wicked prosper, their fate is determined while I rest in the Lord forever.
- 74: In exile, Israel hopes for redemption (remembering Covenant) for You are God.
- 75: Give thanks to the Lord, for He is judge of all the earth.
- 76: Israel is praising God for a battle victory at the hand of the Lord.
- 77: When I am in trouble, I will seek the Lord. I meditate on Your wonderful deeds.
- 78: Tell your children our stories so they may know the handiwork of God & will walk with Him.
- 79: Jerusalem has been destroyed. How long shall we wait on You to destroy our enemies even though we have sinned.
- 80: Restore us, Lord, forgive our sins, shine upon Your people.
- 81: God: my people did not obey & I removed my protection - repent from Your ways.
- 82: Do not judge but instead care for the weak & needy.
- 83: The enemy is upon us, we ask for deliverance.
- 84: Lord, your home (temple) is beautiful, how I wish I could live in your presence there.
- 85: You've forgiven us before, God, we ask for deliverance again, we have confidence you are near.
- 86: I petition before you, Lord. I am in awe of your love, mercy & help to me.
- 87: A psalm of praise of Jerusalem.
- 88: I mourn the nearness of my death, why am I to be separated from you?
- 89: I will praise the Lord & His character - also reviews the irrevocable Davidic covenant.
- 90: You are everlasting God & we are but a fleeting moment, filled with sin, let your grace rest on us.

Help me to remember:

to praise you, even when asking for deliverance they were quick to praise you first.

Lord, I ask that

I be reminded that life is short and time spent with You is never wasted.

the fact you are my defender.
