

Passage: Proverbs 1-15

Date: 2.28.2020

Discovered:

- Seek wisdom, but start at the beginning: fear of the Lord.
- Do not walk with those who sin.
- Those who seek wisdom will be secure but those who ignore it will eat rotten fruit.
- Wisdom is a treasure to seek, a path to guide you.
- Trust in the Lord & not your own understanding. Wisdom adds to your life & heals the body & soul.
- Wisdom is the foundation of creation, make wisdom the foundation of your life.
- Holding tight to wisdom will bring blessings to your life.
- Do not stray from your marriage & rejoice in the love you share.
- Do not be responsible for a neighbor's debt; work hard, don't be lazy or stir up trouble.
- The Lord despises the prideful, liars, murderers, wicked plotters, false witnesses & those who make trouble on purpose & adulterers.
- Those who commit adultery will face consequences - there is no restitution possible.
- Wisdom will help you from falling into the trap of adultery.
- Wisdom is more valuable than gold, silver & jewels.
- Those who seek wisdom & follow its ways will be blessed & find favor.
- You can follow wisdom & reap the benefits or receive the penalty for foolishness.
- Those who speak wisdom are blessed but the wicked speak lies.
- Hatred causes problems, but love is a soothing salve covering all.
- The righteous are delivered while the treacherous are captured by their own cravings, desires.
- The fruit of the righteous are life-giving. The fruit of the wicked are death-bringing.
- The righteous are kind, but the wicked are cruel.
- The wise listen to wisdom, the foolish laugh at it.
- Those who are wise discipline their children.
- Those who have wisdom have confidence in the Lord.
- The Lord hears the prayers of the righteous.
