

Passage: Jeremiah 27-39

Date: 3.15.2020

Discovered: • Send word to kings of Edom, Moab, Ammon, Tyre & Sidon that I, God have given the land to Nebuchadnezzar for 3 generations.

- ↳ Do not believe other prophets - they lie. Do not rebel & it will go well for you.
- Hananiah prophesied that everything/one would come back in 2 years.
 - ↳ Jeremiah confronted him about his lies - would die within the year & he did
- Jeremiah sent a letter to the exiles in Babylon - live life, plant gardens, get married, have children, PRAY TO THE LORD, wait on the Lord, & disregard false prophets.
- Some tried to appeal to Shemaiah but were rebuked & he was punished for his false prophecy.
- The day is coming when I restore Israel, end the exile & eventually establish the new kingdom.
- I will restore your health, fortunes & rebuild Jerusalem, send a ruler from your midst (line of David) - Jesus & you will know me (God).
- I will turn your mourning into dancing, give hope for future & give rest for soul.
- Everyone is responsible for their own sin.
- A new covenant: I will put my law in them, write it on their hearts, I will be their God & they will be my people.
- Jeremiah was imprisoned @ court by Zedekiah during siege. Bought land already captured by Babylon as a show of hope for the return of Israel.
- I will gather my people & bring them back, I will give them one heart, one way to follow.
- God told Jeremiah: I will restore & heal Judah & Israel - I will forgive them
- Some day soon I will fulfill my promise of a righteous branch.
- Lord to Jeremiah told everyone in Jerusalem to free the Hebrew slaves & they did but then they turned around & enslaved them again.
 - ↳ All who broke the covenant would die.
- Jeremiah was told to bring Rechabites to temple & offer wine. They refused because Jonadab had commanded all to not drink wine & to live in tents. They obeyed.
 - ↳ God asked: they obeyed, why can't you? So, I will send disaster as promised.
- Lord tells Jeremiah to write down all of His words. It was given to Baruch to read everywhere he could, so Israel would repent.
 - ↳ When the officials heard the scroll, they were afraid & read it to Jehoiakim. He burned it in the fire. Jehoiakim would die for not listening.
 - ↳ Baruch & Jeremiah were hidden & protected, told to recreate the scroll.
- Zedekiah seeks prayer, Jeremiah tells him Egyptians will leave & Chaldeans will come back & burn the city.
- Jeremiah thrown into prison → thought was deserting
- Jeremiah told Zedekiah, he would be delivered to Babylon, moved to court guard.
- Jeremiah thrown into a cistern & left to die for telling truth but was rescued by an eunuch, Ebed-melech.
- J to Z: Surrender to Babylon & your life spared, city not burned.
- Babylon besieged Jerusalem & it fell. Zedekiah fled but was captured.
 - ↳ Watched nobels & his sons killed before his eyes gouged out & taken to Babylon.
 - ↳ everyone left was captured & taken to Babylon.

Help me to remember:

• Nebuchadnezzar gave instructions to set Jeremiah free & do as he says, take good care of him.
