

Discovered: • All sinners are equal.

- Barren Fig Tree - give me a chance to produce fruit, feed nutrients, if not then cut it down.
- Jesus healed a woman on the Sabbath - made synagogue rulers angry (only heal 6 days) Jesus called them hypocrites.
- Kingdom of God is like mustard seed & leaven: start tiny but grows big
- Many will seek to enter but will not be able to.
- Jesus lamented over Jerusalem because over & over they rejected & killed the prophets sent to them.
- Helping others on the Sabbath is not unlawful.
- Parable of wedding feast: do not take the high place, be humble first & you'll be exalted
- Serve those who cannot return the favor, will be repaid @ resurrection → Do not make excuses to join Him.
- Cost of discipleship is to put Jesus first always - over everything
- Parable of lost sheep: Pharisees grumbled b/c Jesus ate w/ sinners - is like shepherd leaves 99 to find 1.
- Parable of lost coin: be like woman who rejoices when she finds a lost coin
- Prodigal Son: son asks for inheritance, leaves home & spends it all. He returns home & his celebrates his return home.
- Parable of dishonest manager: those faithful w/ little will be faithful with much
↳ cannot serve 2 masters: pick one - God or money
- Pharisees loved the opposite of what God loved.
- Rich man/Lazarus: you alone are responsible for hearing the word of God.
- Temptation to sin is there, but if someone sins & repents - forgive them
- Your faith is what gives you power - be willing to serve the Lord.
- Jesus cleansed 10 lepers, but only 1 returned to praise Him - show thankfulness.
- Son of Man must suffer & be rejected, life will continue until His return.
- God hears our prayers & will answer them (we may not like the answer) - He hears our cries.
- Kingdom of God belongs to those who have child-like faith.
- Jesus foretells His death a 3rd time, & healed a blind man w/ faith.
- Jesus ate w/ Zacchaeus (tax collector) served joyfully - Zacchaeus repented & restored 4-fold. Made Pharisees angry.
- Parable of 10 minas - upon His return, enemies destroyed & those who do will be given more.
- Jesus sent disciples ahead to Jerusalem for a city. He rode into town celebrated as a King.
- Jesus cleaned the temple & taught daily. Pharisees tried to challenge His authority but could not answer His questions.
- Parable of wicked tenants: just as tenants rejected owner, the cornerstone (Jesus) will be rejected
- Give to Caesar what is his & give to God what is His. (Widow gave everything to the Lord.)
- Jesus foretells destruction of temple, wars, persecution & destruction of Jerusalem.
- The Son of Man will come in a cloud w/ glory & power, until be aware & pray for strength.
- Judas agreed to betray Jesus @ Passover
- Jesus celebrated Passover w/ disciples & taught the Lord's supper: bread = body & wine = blood
- Jesus went to pray @ Mount of Olives & arrested (betrayed by Judas's kiss) by chief priests.
- Peter denied Jesus 3 times while waiting as predicted by Jesus.
- Jesus was mocked & beaten & given guilty verdict by council, sent Him to Pilate to be executed, but Pilate found Jesus not guilty & sent Him to Herod who sent Him back to Pilate

- ↳ Pilate tried to set Jesus free but the crowd wanted Barabas, so he sent Jesus to be crucified.
- Jesus was crucified between 2 criminals.
- Joseph of Arimathea got permission to bury Jesus in his tomb.
- Women went to tomb but found it empty & were told He is Risen.
- Women tried to tell disciples but they did not believe.
- Jesus appeared to 2 disciples while traveling to Emmaus
↳ Jesus then appeared to all & told to stay put until they received the Holy Spirit.
↳ then He ascended up into heaven
