

Passage: John 1-10

Date: September 16

Discovered: • Word = Jesus

- God sent John to tell about Jesus coming
- Jesus came to live among us, & all who receive Christ & believe in His name are children of God
- Jesus sent people to ask who John was & why he was baptizing w/ water. (The greater one to come)
- John baptized Jesus & the Holy Spirit came to rest on Jesus.
- 2 disciples left John to follow Jesus: one (Andrew) went to fetch his brother, Peter
- In Galilee, Jesus called Philip & Nathanael to join Him.
- Jesus turned water into wine @ a wedding in Cana.
- During Passover, Jesus drove all the money makers from the temple
- Jesus foretells His death & resurrection by telling He would destroy the temple & rebuild it in 3 days (His Body)
- Nicodemus asked how one could be born again in order to see the Kingdom of God: be born of water & the Spirit
- God sent His son to die so that we can live forever w/ Him.
- John understood that he must decrease & Jesus must increase.
- Jesus returns to Galilee & passes through Samaria & asked a woman to give Him a drink from the well & offered Her living water
 - ↳ she went to gather all from the town to hear from the Messiah, stayed 2 days & many became believers.
- An official sought healing for his son @ Capernaum. He believed Jesus when He said his son would be healed.
- Jesus healed a man on the Sabbath @ the pool - Get up & walk.
 - ↳ Jews were angry Jesus healed on Sabbath & He called God His Father (equal w/ God)
- Father does not judge, gave that power to Jesus → those who believe have eternal life
- Jesus: Moses wrote about me, you believe Moses, why not in me?
- Jesus fed 5,000 w/ 5 loaves & 2 fish from a boy's lunch & there were leftovers
- Disciples went across the sea, Jesus joined them by walking on the water & instantly once in the boat, they arrived.
- People followed Jesus across the sea: He told them to seek bread of life
 - ↳ Jews grumbled because they knew Him (couldn't be Savior). He was their neighbor
 - ↳ many disciples left Jesus. 12 remained (including Judas who would betray Jesus)
- Jesus taught at festival of booths. Amazed @ His knowledge. He criticized their lack of following the law.
- They sought to arrest Him - did not believe / those who believed did not have Holy Spirit
- Jesus was teaching in the temple & they brought a woman who was committing adultery
 - ↳ Judgment: let one who sin throw first stone, no accusers. He let her go, sin no more
- Jesus told them again. He was the Messiah but only some believed.
- If you know me & my word, you will be free, no longer a slave to sin
- Jews accused Jesus of being a Samaritan & having a demon.
 - ↳ I came before Abraham → this made them angry & they threw stones @ Him
- Jesus healed a blind man → Pharisees could not believe someone could heal on Sabbath
- Jesus: I am the good shepherd who lays down my life for the sheep
 - ↳ I willingly give up my life

• At feast of dedication, they demanded to know if He was Christ. He told them, I told you & you do not believe.

↳ they picked up rocks to stone for blasphemy & tried to arrest Him
↳ He went across the Jordan.
