Galatians

- Discoveries:

 - Paul wrote a letter to Church @ Galatia
 - Paul was surprised that so many were led away from God by false teachers & teachings. May false teachers be cursed.
 - As a servant of Christ, I need to seek approval from God not man.
 - Paul told them he was saved because of God's grace, was sought out by God. After conversion, he went to Arabia.
 - 3 years later, Paul went to Jerusalem to meet w/ Peter, then went to Syria to teach. Judea rejoiced when they heard Paul was no longer persecuting believers. (It wasn't)
 - 14 years later, Paul went before apostles to make sure his ministry was not in vain: spread gospel to Gentiles.
 - Paul rebuked Peter for not acknowledging saved Gentiles for fear of insulting Jews (who do we please?)
 - Regardless of our birth, we are saved by faith in Christ, not by deeds (Old Law) - promise of Abraham
 - Because I was crucified w/ Christ - Christ now lives in me. If we are made righteous by the Law - Christ died in vain & He did not!
 - The Law was given to be a helper to sinners until Christ could come, a guardian to watch over us.
 - The Abrahamic Covenant precedes the Mosaic Covenant (law) therefore the Law DOES NOT replace promise: nations who believe in Christ are the true Israelites (blessing of all)
 - The Law was meant to show us our sins, so that when Christ arrived, we would see how badly we needed Him & His grace.
 - All (regardless of status, birth, nationality) who belong to Christ & accepted Him are heirs to His promise.
 - We were under the Law just as children are under a guardian to learn the ropes.
 - Before you knew God, you followed the world. I worry that you will return to the world & my efforts in vain.
 - My affliction allowed me to tell you of Him even when it could have driven you away, you received me with honor.
 - Am I your enemy because I told you the truth, don't allow false teachers to lead astray. I wish I could be w/ you.
 - Abraham had 2 sons: one by slave flesh (Isaac), one by free (Isaac) through promise. Paul compares Hagar & Sarah.

H: Current day Jerusalem: slave to sin S: future redeemed: Jerusalem living in freedom

In Christ, we've been freed - don't return to slavery (sin) (Circumcision not required)

If you believe, you need to follow the law to be justified then you don't believe in Christ → only faith out of love saves

Some thought Paul taught circumcision, if so why was he still persecuted? False teachers will have consequences

Through Christ, we've been given freedom - use it wisely: serve w/ love, act out God's examples

Know the difference between works of flesh & fruit of the spirit.

When others sin, we should gently steer them back. Be sure to examine ourselves for conceit. We reap what we sow, so we need to sow Christ.

Boast in Christ's crucifixion & being a new creation in Christ - if we live this out, we receive mercy & grace.

Galatians - We have been given every spiritual blessing by God through Christ.

• We were predestined to be adopted by Christ - we've been forgiven of our sins, given grace, sealed by Holy Spirit & given inheritance.

Ephesians - We have been given every spiritual blessing by God through Christ.

- We were predestined to be adopted by Christ - we've been forgiven of our sins, given grace, sealed by Holy Spirit & given inheritance.
 - Paul gives thanks that they know Jesus & prays they will be enlightened to greatness of His power - He raised Christ from dead & seated Him @ right hand & gave Him authority over all.
Even though our sins cause our death, we are made alive through Christ & seated w/Him. We have been saved by our faith b/c of His Grace.
We are God's handiwork.
 - We were once separated but through Christ's blood we have been brought near & become citizens in God's family & dwelling place for Holy Spirit.
It was revealed to Paul the mystery of the gospel - that Gentiles are included heirs, His ministry to tell them.
 - We are called to walk in unity - humble, patient, treat others lovingly & use our individual gifts to grow body of Christ.
As we grow & mature in our knowledge, we are better able to proclaim truth & grow whole body.

Help me to remember:

Christ died to redeem us & by only
faith in Him, I am saved.

Because I have Christ, I am to live
outloud for God - in love & light,
showing fruit of the Spirit.

Lord, I ask that

I am able to be a beacon
for Your loving kindness to
those whose paths I cross
in the world.

- We've been given new life: we must act like it, speak truth, don't sin out of anger, be encouraging & forgiving.
 - Walk in light & love, be a beacon of light, avoid immorality & debauchery.
 - Wives submit to your husband as the Church submits to Christ. Husband is the head of family as Christ is head of Church.
 - Husbands love your wives as Christ loves the church - just as you love & cherish your body - do the same for your wife.

children obey your parents - 1st commandment w/ promise: so it goes well w/ you. Fathers don't provoke your children but instruct them about the Lord.

bond servants - obey your masters & serve them as if you are serving the Lord. Masters don't threaten your servants.
